Randy Lee Rogers, 58, of 114 Bent Tree Drive, Blairs, VA died on Sunday, August 19, 2012 at his residence after being in declining health for several months.

Mr. Rogers was born in Danville, VA on July 2, 1954 a son of the late James Barksdale Rogers and the late Harriett Hawker Rogers. He spent all of his life in Danville area where he was involved with youth sports and canine rescue.
