Ray Thomas Gosney, 83, of 4010 Keswick Drive, Danville, VA, died Thursday, February 6, 2014 at Riverside Health and Rehabilitation Center after being in declining health for one week.

Born in Pittsylvania County, VA on April 30, 1930, he was a son of the late Jesse H. Gosney and Latane Owens Gosney.
