*Thank you for all the memories and stories he told us. They are the memories we will remember.*

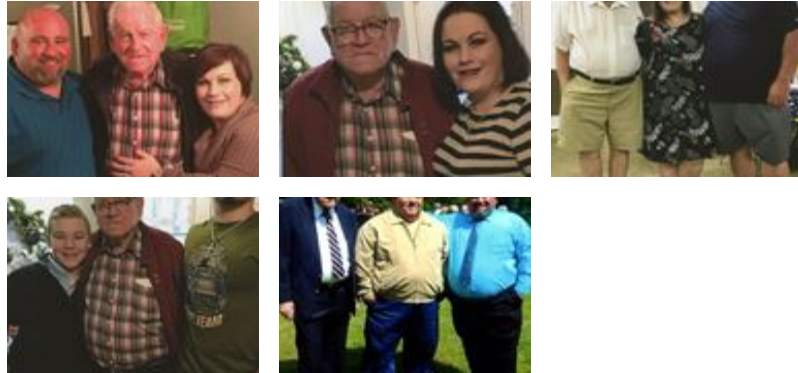

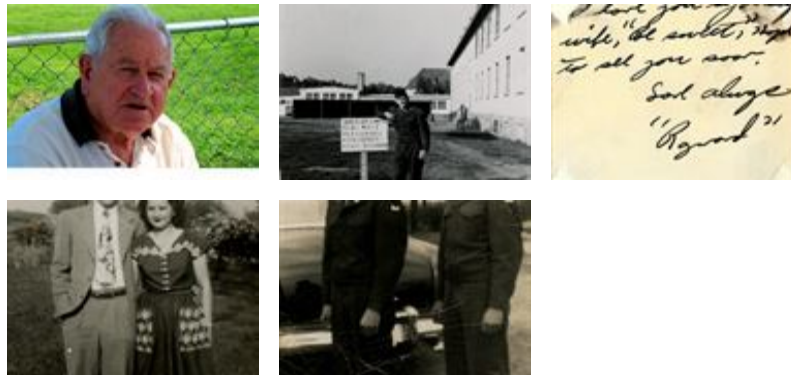
