March 22, 1933 - June 12, 2010

Mr. Raymond Bradford Hyler, age 77 of 598 Mangrums Road, Danville, died Saturday morning, June 12, 2010 at his residence after a decline in health for the past six months. Mr. Hyler was born on March 22, 1933 in Pittsylvania County, a son of the late Robert Allen Hyler and the late Helen Haley Hyler. He had lived most of his life in the Danville area.
