Raymond Malloy Markham, 78, of 1485 Hobson Road Axton, VA went home to be with the Lord on Saturday, May 17, 2014 at his residence after a decline in health since 1999.

Mr. Markham was born on May 22, 1935 in Caswell County, NC a son of the late Earl Richard Markham and the late Minnie Clayton Markham.
