October 5, 1948 - April 6, 2023

In the early morning hours of Thursday, April 6, 2023, after a long hard fight with AML/Cancer, Rebecca (Becky) “Moppy” DeHart passed peacefully in her home.

Becky was born on October 5th 1948 to the late Andrew Franklin Moore and the late Violet Canipe Moore, in Newton, NC. She was a sweet and loving child that played with dolls and took care of her brothers. She graduated from Maiden High School in 1966. She attended Averett College after her children were born, where she earned her Bachelor's Degree in Education to become an elementary school teacher. Becky was a caring and exemplary teacher. Her natural kindness, fun spirit, and empathy for others allowed her to truly bond and grow relationships with her students and colleagues. She spent 30 years teaching elementary students in Danville and an additional 2 years teaching in Eden, NC.

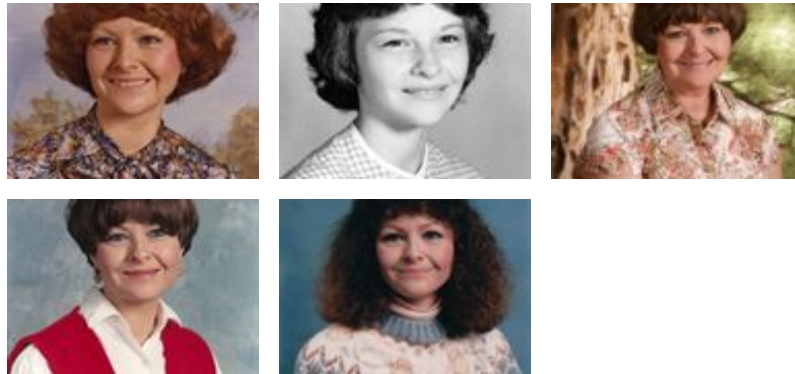
