Rebecca Childress Guill, 78, of 1205 Greenwood Drive died Friday, September 16, 2011, at Danville Regional Medical Center. Mrs. Guill was born on August 27, 1933, in Danville, the daughter of the late William Witcher Childress and Ellen Mitchell Childress. She graduated from the Memorial Hospital School of Nursing in 1955. Mrs. Guill was a dedicated and loyal nurse for more than forty years, retiring from Roman Eagle Memorial Home as a supervisor in 1996. She was an active member of Blairs Baptist Church, where she was a member of the WMU. On December 24, 1953, she married Horace Lee Guill, who survives. In addition to her husband of the residence, survivors include a daughter, Ellen G. Bass, and husband, Chris; two sons, H. Lee Guill, Jr., and Mark T. Guill, and wife, Kathy; and three precious grandchildren, Matthew Alan Bass, Heather Renee Bass, and Ashley Lynn Guill. Additionally, she is survived by two sisters, Elsie McKinney and Kate Moore, and one brother, George Childress. She was predeceased by a sister, Josephine G. Travis, a brother, Charles Childress, nine half-sisters and five half-brothers.
