



## Rev. Rodney Bernard Dalton

November 9, 1963 - September 2, 2021

Rev. Rodney Bernard Dalton, 57, of 6788 Slatesville Road, Keeling, VA went home to be with Lord on Thursday, September 2, 2021 after being in declining health for the past six months.

Rodney was born in Danville, VA on November 9, 1963 a son to the late Rodger D. Dalton and Margaret Gammon Dalton. He had lived all of his life in the Keeling community of Pittsylvania County where had worked as truck driver until his retirement due to his health. Rodney was a graduate of Dan River High School, Class of 1982.

Rodney was a member of the Central Blvd. Church of God when he first entered into the ministry, he later became the Youth Pastor for the Westover Church of God prior to establishing and becoming the Pastor of the Cyrus Springs Church of God where he served for 17 years. He was affiliated with the Good Men's Ministry serving the area nursing homes and other facilities spreading the word of God.

Rodney also volunteered with God's Pit Crew for several years. He had served with U.S. Army and the Virginia National Guard. In July of 1982 he married the love of his life, Sharon A. Dalton who survives of the residence.
