Richard Allen Dailey, 88, of 1051 Dailey Road, Blanch, NC, went home to be with the Lord on Thursday, March 14, 2024 at AuthoraCare Collective, Burlington, NC after a brief illness.

Richard was born on February 2, 1936 to the late I. G. Dailey, Sr. and Edith VanAllen Dailey. He spent most of his life in Caswell County. Richard was a graduate of Bartlett Yancey High School. He worked for the N.C. Department of Corrections for 30 years. After retirement he worked an additional 10 year's part time. Richard enjoyed horseback riding, working on the farm and hunting. He was a member of Caswell Brotherhood Lodge #11. Richard was a member of Purley United Methodist Church.

On May 19, 1956, he married Billie McLendon Dailey who survives of the residence. Richard is survived by three sons, Allen Dailey and wife Jenny of Sumter, SC., Rick Dailey and wife Nancy of Burlington, NC, Tracy Dailey of Blanch, NC, and former daughter-in-law, Nikki Hodges, one brother, I.
