Richard T. McGhee, Jr., 78, of 222 Courtland Street (Holiday Village) died Friday at Gretna Health Care Center. He had been in declining health for six months. Mr. McGhee was born September 26, 1931 in the Ridley Township, Pennsylvania a son of Richard T. McGhee, Sr. and Fannie Bell McGhee. He had lived in Grit, VA and Cheraw, SC before moving to Danville. Mr. McGhee had worked in textiles for Burlington Industries and was a veteran of the U.S. Army, serving after World War II. He attended Kentuck Baptist Church.
