Robert Lee Ford, 94, of North Danville, died Monday, June 20, 2011 at the Woltz Hospice Home in Dobson, NC.

Mr. Ford was born in Ash County, NC on September 17, 1916, the son of the late Robert Austin Ford and Etta Mae Osborne Ford.

He worked in Dan River Mills #8 as a spinner for 33 years. He was a member of the American Legion Post # 325 and the VFW# 647. He was of the Baptist Faith.

He served in the U.S. Army during WWII as a Staff Sergeant 45th Infantry Division, seeing battle action in Sicily, France, Italy, and Germany. He was awarded a Bronze Star, six Battle Stars, Presidential Citation, and Infantry Combat Badge.

He was married to Nannie Yeatts Wyatt Ford, who died on March 17, 2011.

Survivors include two step-daughters, Evelyn Satterfield, and husband, Willard, of Alton; Vicky LaRue, and husband, Troy, of South Boston; three step-sons, Ronald Wyatt, and wife Gayle; Bobby Wyatt, both of Danville; Larry

Wyatt, and wife Alice, of Providence, NC; a sister, Mozelle Boyd, of Elkin, NC; seven step-grandchildren, and four step-great-grandchildren.

Graveside services will be held on Thursday, June 23, 2011, at 11:00 A.M. at Danville Memorial Gardens conducted by the Rev. Daryl Joyce. Flag presentation will be conducted by the U.S. Army.
