July 27, 1930 - March 11, 2012

Mr. Robert Earl Platt, age 81 of 721 Tuscarora Drive, entered into rest with his Lord on March 11, 2012 surrounded by family. Mr. Platt was born on July 27, 1930 in Greenwich, CT., a son of the late Clifford Platt, Sr. and the late Hazel Clough Platt. He served in the U.S. Navy between 1947 to 1954. He joined the New York City Fire Department in 1965 and retired in 1985. He moved to Danville in 1986. He was an active member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church. He held all official offices of the Knights of Columbus, past President of the Sons of the American Revolution, Dan River Chapter, Virginia Society. He was also a member of the American Legion Post #325. Mr. Platt is survived by his wife, Kathleen E. Platt of 57 years, two sons, a daughter, a daughter-in-law, five grandchildren and a brother, Clifford K. Platt, Jr. A Catholic Prayer Service will be held on Tuesday evening, March 13, 2011 at Sacred Heart Catholic Church at 6:30 pm. The family will receive friends following the service from 7:00 to 9:00 pm.
