Robert Minter Woodall, Sr., 89, of 149 Executive Court, Danville, VA died surrounded by his loving daughters on November 7, 2015 in Carilion Hospital in Roanoke, VA after being in declining health for one year.

Mr. Woodall was born in the Swansonville Community of Pittsylvania County on November 5, 1926 the son of the late Taylor Patrick Woodall and Dochie Minter Woodall. He had lived all of his life in Pittsylvania County & Danville, VA. Mr. Woodall had worked in Insurance for over thirty years having owned Robert Woodall Insurance Agency until his retirement.
