Ronald Saunders Brooks, Sr. was born September 3, 1944, in Danville, Virginia. He lived his entire life in the Westover Hills area, making lifelong friends and memories. After graduating from Brosville High School in 1962, Ronald became a general contractor, following in his father's footsteps. He and his brother worked alongside their father for many years, building homes in Danville and Pittsylvania County as A.B. Brooks & Sons. In 1980, the Brooks Families opened Brooks Bros. General Store on Westover Drive. Ronald and his brother were lifelong friends and business partners.

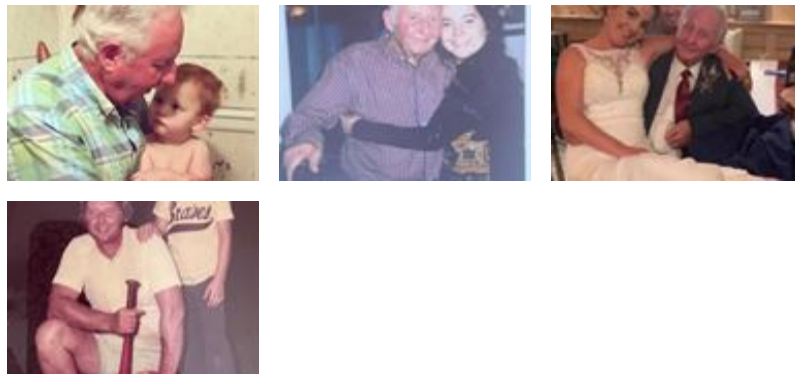

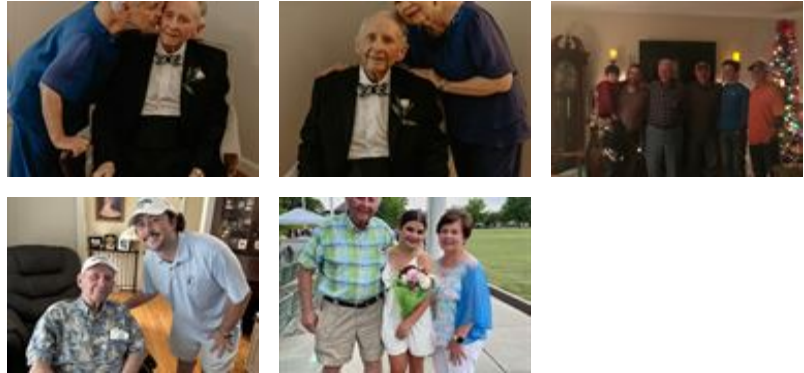
