Ronald Wayne Carter, 65, of 280 Echo Lane, Ringgold, VA, died on Wednesday, October 22, 2014 at the VA Medical Center in Durham, NC, after being in declining health for several years.

Mr. Carter was born on February 17, 1949 in Danville, VA, son of the late Eugene Lenwood Carter and the late Sally Powell Carter. He spent most of his life in the Pittsylvania County area where he was a graduate of Chatham High School, Class of 1967. Mr. Carter proudly served his country in the United States Air Force during Vietnam, as a Fuel Specialist from 1967 to 1972 and returning to Danville worked for Dan River Inc. until his retirement due to his health. He was a lifelong member of the V.F.W. Post 647 where he was a Past Commander and past 5th District Commander and was currently serving as Junior Vice Commander. He was a member of St. Mark Pentecostal Holiness Church.

On February 14, 1974 he married Lottie Murphy Carter who survives of the residence.

Also surviving are, son, Scott Carter and wife Elizabeth of Ringgold, VA; daughter, Susan Carter Hendrix and husband Arnold of Danville, VA; brother, Eugene Carter of Dry Fork, VA.
