Ronald Edward Clark, Sr., 68, of Ringgold, VA, died on Friday, April 7, 2017 after a decline in his health for the past five years.

Born on August 3, 1948, he was a son of the late William Edward Clark and Elva Richardson Clark. He lived most of his life in Ringgold, VA and retired from Times Fiber where he had worked as an electrician. Prior to Times Fiber he worked for ADT.

Ronald was a member of Rock Springs United Methodist Church. He graduated from Dan River High School. He was a veteran, serving in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam War.

He was married to JoAnn Vassar Clark, who survives.

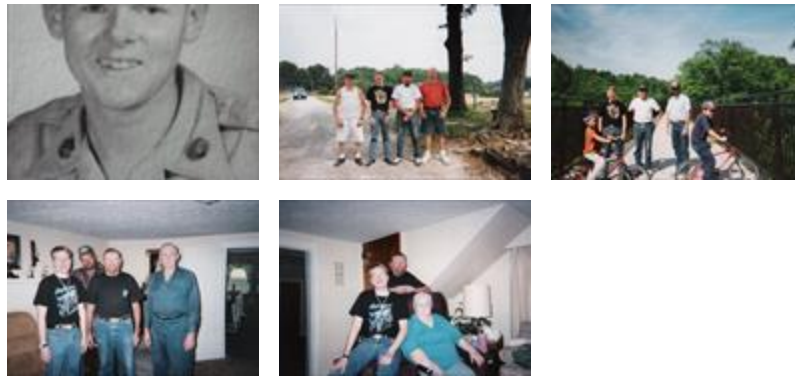

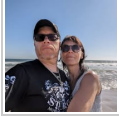
