Ronnie Lee Lynch, 68, of 300 Varley Lane, Martinsville, VA passed away on Monday, December 8, 2014 at the VA Hospital in Salem, VA after a decline in health for the past 15 years.

He was of the Baptist faith. He proudly served his country in the United States Army from 1966 to 1968, He fought in Vietnam and was in the Big Red 1.
