



Rosemary Monahan Jones

Rosemary Monahan Jones, age 86, of 224 Crosland Avenue, Danville, VA, died Tuesday, October 14, 2014 at her residence. She had been in declining health since 2003.

Mrs. Jones was born in Chicago, Illinois, on October 19, 1927, a daughter of the late John Monahan and the late Mabel Smith Monahan. She lived her early years in Medford, MA, and in Anchorage, Alaska, where she worked for the State of Alaska as a Registered Nurse before moving to Danville, VA in 1967.

She retired from Roman Eagle Memorial Home as an RN. She was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church.

Mrs. Jones was a veteran, serving in the United States Air Force during the Korean War.

On October 10, 1959 she married Donald D. Jones, who survives.
