



Rufus Weldon Morris

March 26, 1939 - October 27, 2021

Rufus Weldon Morris, Sr., 82, of Ringgold, VA, went home to be with the Lord on Wednesday, October 27, 2021 at the Woltz Hospice Home, Dobson, NC, after being in declining health for the past year.

Mr. Morris was born in South Boston, VA, on March 26, 1939, a son of the late Andrew Jackson Morris and the late Barbara Mae Ford Morris. He spent most of his life in the Danville area where he worked for Dan River Mills for 40 years. He then went to work for ABB in South Boston, VA, until his retirement. In his spare time, he enjoyed working on cars and watching NASCAR races. He was of the Baptist Faith.

On April 8, 1961, he married Marion Virginia Creasy Morris, who survives of the residence.
