April 3, 1921 - October 23, 2009

Ruth Elizabeth Taylor Maxie, 88, of 2600 Mount Cross Road, died Friday, October 23, 2009 at Danville Regional Medical Center. She had been in declining health for the past ten months and in the hospital two weeks.
