Ruth Darnell McGregor, 89, of 231 Ridge Street, Apt 120, Danville, VA died on Monday, August 19, 2013 at Danville Regional Medical Center after being in declining health for several years.

Mrs. McGregor was born in Pittsylvania County, VA on April 24, 1924, a daughter of the late Lonnie Evander Darnell and the late Eunice Alley Darnell. She spent all of her life in the Danville area where she was co owner of the Green Tree Restaurant and she also worked as a clerk at Belk-Leggett. She was a member of River Oak Church of God.
