Ruth S. Settle, 79, of Danville, VA, died Saturday, April 21, 2018 at SOVAH Health of Danville after a decline in health for the past few years.

Mrs. Settle was born in Pittsylvania County, VA, on September 17, 1938, a daughter of the late John Henry Searce and the late Beulah Doris Simpson Searce. She spent most of her life in the Danville area where she worked for Danville Regional Medical Center as an LPN. She was a member of Rivermont Baptist Church where she served on the Homebound Ministry.

She was married to John R. Settle, who died on May 8, 1988.
