Samuel Delma Norman, 90, of 4060 Suburban Dr., Danville, VA died on Saturday, April 11, 2020 at Roman Eagle Rehabilitation and Health Care after being in declining health for a couple weeks.

Mr. Norman was born in Lincoln County, GA on October 10, 1929, son of the late Willie Frank Norman and Minnie Thornton Norman. He enlisted in the United States Navy at age 17 and served from 1947 until 1957. He then went on to work as an electrician. He retired from Goodyear Tire and Rubber Co in 1994. He was a member of Mt. Pleasant UMC. Mr. Norman was known for being a handyman who could fix anything whether it was something electrical or plumbing related.

Mr. Norman was devoted to his family and those he leaves behind are his loving wife, Marcelle Rollins Norman; sons, Kenneth Allen Norman (Janice) of Jensen Beach, FL. and David Lee Norman (Sue) of Danville, VA; daughter Maryanne Higgins of Charlottesville, VA; brother, Thornton A.
