Samuel B. "Shorty" Prevette Jr., age 84, of Miles City, Montana, passed away on Tuesday, November 13, 2012 at the Holy Rosary Hospital in Miles City.

Samuel was born on December 20, 1927 in Couleemee, North Carolina, the son of Samuel Sr. and Julia Creason Prevette. He attended grade school there through the 3rd grade.
