Shelby Bliss Robertson, 84, of 480 Afton Rd., Danville, VA, went home to be with the Lord on Friday, October 15, 2021 at Roman Eagle Rehab and Healthcare Center, after being in declining health for the past year.

Mrs. Robertson was born in Pittsylvania County, VA on March 11, 1937, a daughter of the late Charles Alexander Bliss, Sr. and the late Virginia Vernon Bliss. She spent all of her life in the Pittsylvania County area where she was a homemaker. She was a member of Blairs Baptist Church where she taught Children's Sunday School for 26 years.
