



Shirley Martin Brumfield Sr.

August 12, 1926 - January 3, 2015

Shirley Martin Brumfield, Sr., 88, of Sherwood Drive, Danville, VA, passed away Saturday, January 3, 2015 at Danville Regional Medical Center.

Mr. Brumfield was born in Pittsylvania County, VA, on August 12, 1926, a son of the late Clarence Dameron Brumfield and Annie Mae Grant Brumfield. He had been a resident of Danville since August 17, 1991 when he moved back from Charlotte, NC. Mr. Brumfield worked with Overnight in Danville for over nineteen years. He retired as General Manager from Young Transfer of Charlotte, NC. He was a veteran, serving in the U.S. Navy in WWII. He was of the Methodist faith. Mr. Brumfield was a life member of Greenwood Lodge #91, of Greenwood, SC., the V.F.W. Ballard Pruitt Post 647, the Military Order of the Cooties, and the State V.F.W. Commanders Club. He was a member of the American Legion Dan River Post 1097 and the Pocahontas Tribe #124 Order of the Redmen. On May 15, 1944 he married June Clayton Brumfield, who survives.

In addition to his wife, of the residence, he is survived by a daughter, Deborah B. Lefler, and husband David Michael of Lexington, TN; six grandchildren, nine great grandchildren and two great great grandchildren. He was predeceased by a daughter, Macy Frances Brumfield; two sons, Shirley M. Brumfield, Jr. and Stephen Michael Brumfield; a brother, Horace D. Brumfield; and a sister, Vivian B. Fraser.

A graveside service will be held on Tuesday, January 6, 2015 at 2:00 P.M. in Highland Burial Park with the Rev. Dr. Larry Aaron officiating. Military honors will be conducted by the American Legion Dan River Post 1097. At other times the family will be at the residence.
