Shizuko Zamami Woods 88, of Ringgold, VA passed away on Wednesday, July 28, 2021 at Riverside Health and Rehabilitation Center after being in declining health for several years.

Shizuko was born in Okinawa, Japan on July 13, 1933, daughter of the late Zamami Soko and Zamami Ushi. She spent her early life in Okinawa, Japan and was the fifth daughter of eight children. Shizuko survived WW2 as a child and eventually married. She moved to Carlsbad, CA in 1961 with her husband Ferguson Woods.

After many years of working hard, she moved to the Danville area in 1993 to be near family. She spent her retirement putting around town and quietly at home. She was lovingly cared for 18 years by her sister with the help and support of other friends and family.
