



Stephen Allen Reynolds

Stephen Allen Reynolds, 67, of 276 Lovell Drive, Danville, VA passed away at his residence on Monday, November 19, 2024 after being in declining health for several years.

Stephen was born in Fort Bragg, NC on April 4, 1957, a son of the late Hubert “Tooney” Walton Reynolds, Jr. and Evelyn Doss Reynolds.

He graduated from George Washington High School in 1976 and soon after enlisted in the United States Air Force, where he trained as an aircraft mechanic. He was also very dedicated to keeping his personal cars in perfect condition, always making sure they were clean and well-maintained. Reynolds.

Stephen is survived by his mother, Evelyn Reynolds of Danville, VA; his son, Stephen James Reynolds of Danville, VA; and his sister, Kimberly Dawn Reynolds of Danville, VA.
