Ryland Stephen “Steve” Moore, 60, of 1192 Cedar Rd, Ringgold, VA, died on Monday, June 19, 2017 at his residence after being in declining health since April.

Steve was born in Ringgold, VA on July 31, 1956, son of the late Ryland Nelson Moore and Shirley Jean Alvis Moore who survives of Myrtle Beach, SC. He spent his entire life in the Dry Fork and Ringgold communities where he worked for ITG Brands as a forklift operator. He was an avid drummer and played in many bands throughout his life. He attended Open Bible Baptist Church in Chatham, VA.

In addition to his mother, Steve is survived by his daughters, Hannah L. Boyd (Greg) of Martinsville, VA and Stephenie D. Moore of Danville, VA, who was his primary caregiver during his sickness.

the Reverend Tim Kyser officiating. Interment will follow the service in Floral Hills Memory Gardens.
