Dr. Steven A. Upchurch, 74, passed away June 6 at his residence. Born in Boston, Massachusetts and grew up in Scituate, Mass. He moved to Greensboro and later Caswell County after graduating from Tufts University Dental School, Boston, Massachusetts and practiced dentistry in Yanceyville for 40 years.

He was a former chief of the Casville Volunteer Fire Department where he served many years.
