Frances Susan Carter Merricks, 92, of 149 Executive Court Danville, VA, died Saturday March 17, 2012 at Riverside Health and Rehab. Born in Pittsylvania County, VA, she was the daughter of the late Charlie Allen Carter and Nannie Hardy Carter. She spent most of her life in the Brosville community where she was a homemaker. She was an active member of Hillcrest Baptist Church where she was a choir member, past Sunday School Teacher, and a member of the W.M.U. On September 16, 1938 she married Clarence Coleman Merricks who died on April 1, 1998. Survivors include a son, J.C. Merricks, of Burlington, NC; two daughters, Nancye M. Jones, of Hilton Head, SC; Denise M. Hudson, of Greenville, NC; a brother, Hardy Carter, of Danville, VA; a sister, Lois C. Scarce, of Coco Beach, FL; nine grandchildren, twelve great-grandchildren, and one great-great-grandchild. In addition to her husband she was predeceased by four sisters and five brothers.
