Susan Amanda Childress Wilkerson, 71, stepped into eternity on Saturday, October 24, 2020 at her home in Ringgold, VA, following a courageous battle with Ovarian Cancer with her husband, Jimmy by her side.

Susan was born in Lexington, NC to the late William Hasten Childress and Betty Kepley Childress. Before her retirement in 2015, she worked at Owens Illinois which was the former Brockway Glass. She held numerous positions before her last position as Customer Service Representative. 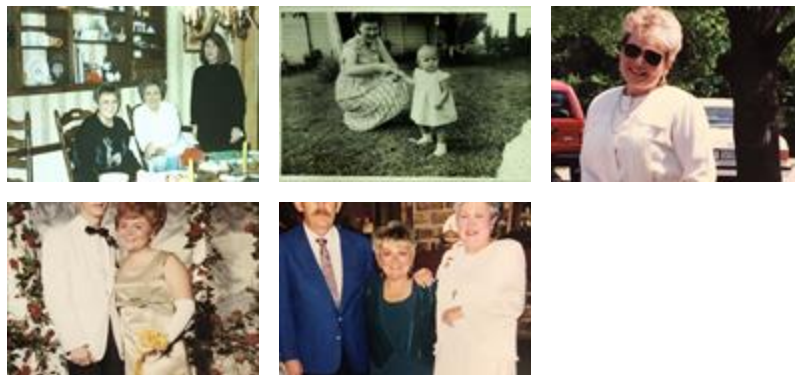
