Theron Avis Hall, 85, of Danville went home to be with the Lord on Monday, February 21, 2022.

Born in Grayson County, VA on April 17, 1936 a son of the late Horton Albert Hall, Sr., and Ella Molly Carico Hall.

Theron served in the US Navy. He was an over the road truck driver for Dan River Inc. where he had 31 years of safe driving. He was the founder and Pastor of Whippoorwill Forest Church of Christ in Pelham, NC. He was a member of the American Legion Post # 325 and the David Cox Chapter of SAR, Cabell Graves Camp of SCV.

On August 20, 1955, he married Barbara Hackler Hall, who survives.
