Thomas C. Berry, 85, of 1074 Linden Lane died on Tuesday, May 3, 2011 at his residence after being in declining health for several months.

Mr. Berry was born in Millstead, GA on September 28, 1925 a son of the late Bert Paul Berry and the late Mary Ruth Plant Berry. He had lived in the Danville area since 1996 and was a retired truck driver for Smith Transfer. He served his country in the US Army and fought in WWII. He was a member of Emmanuel Church of the Brethren where he served on the church board and was an usher. He was also a member of the American Legion Dan River Post 1097, VFW Ballard Pruitt No. 647, and he was an avid bowler.

On April 9, 1988 he married Wanda Forrester Berry, who survives of the residence.

Mr. Berry was predeceased by his parents;his first wife, Ida Mae Berry; a son, Thomas ?Buddy? Berry; a step son, Ben Conner; and a sister, Gladys Watson.

Funeral services will be conducted on Friday May 6, 2011 at 7:00 P.M. from the Wrenn-Yeatts Westover Chapel with the Reverend Curtis English and the Reverend Leonard Martin officiating. A private burial will be held in Georgia at a later date.
