



Thomas Harley Camp

August 13, 1929 - December 18, 2023

Thomas Harley Camp, 94, of Round Rock, TX, died Monday, December 18, 2023 at Rolling Rivers Assisted Living, Round Rock, TX, after a decline in his health since September of 2022.

Thomas was born in Charlotte, NC, on August 13, 1929, a son of the late Thomas Franklin Camp and Agnes Mae Davis Camp.

He was a veteran, proudly serving in the U.S. Navy in the Korean War for 5 years. Thomas was of the Methodist faith, and he served as a Mason

Thomas retired after 37 years from the Department of Agriculture where he worked as a research leader.

He lived his life in Washington, DC before moving to Austin, TX in 1970, Bryan, TX, and then to Georgetown, TX in 1990. He had been a resident of Round Rock, TX since 2022.

Thomas enjoyed doing it yourself projects, gardening, working around his home, and traveling.

On March 20, 1953 he married Frances Rogers Camp, who died on February 13, 1998. He was married a second time in 1999 to Sheila M. Camp, she died in October of 2021.

In addition to his spouses, Thomas was predeceased by two brothers, James V. Camp, and Harold David Camp; and a sister, Barbara Camp Heffinger.

Survivors include two sons, Thomas H. Camp, Jr. of Austin, TX, and Landon G. Camp (Veronica) of Round Rock, TX; two grandchildren, Miranda Camp and Ian Camp, of Round Rock, TX; and two brothers, Max T. Camp of Huntsville, AL, and Richard E. Camp of Chatham, VA.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday, December 28, 2023 at 2:00 P.M. at the Wrenn-Yeatts Westover Chapel with the Reverend Mikel Pugh officiating. Interment will follow the service in Danville Memorial Gardens with Military Honors conducted by the U.S. Navy Reserve Honor Guard.

The family will receive friends on Thursday, at the funeral home, from 12:30 until 1:45 P.M. before the service.

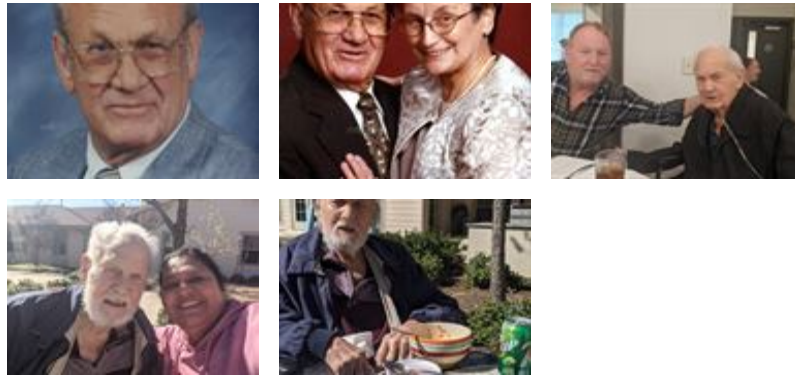
