



# Thomas David Newcomb

June 23, 1958 - July 21, 2022

Thomas David Newcomb, 64, of Danville, Virginia, departed this life on Thursday, July 21, 2022 after a decline in health since 2013.

Born in Danville, VA on June 23, 1958, a son of the late Clarence Allen Newcomb and Lois Magllene Yeatts Newcomb, Thomas worked for Columbia Flooring as a multi-grade technician. Before that, he worked for Dan River for 26 years. He spent his early life in Henderson, North Carolina, before moving to Danville, Virginia in 1979.

He married Jean Marie Powell Newcomb, who survives, on August 14, 2010.

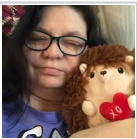
