



## Thomas "Tommy" Neal McGee Sr.

August 6, 1941 - May 11, 2017

Thomas "Tommy" Neal McGee, Sr., of Pelham, NC died on Thursday, May 11, 2017 at Moses Cone Memorial Hospital in Greensboro, NC after a decline in health for the past year.

Mr. McGee was born in Danville, VA on August 6, 1941, a son of the late Johnny Neal McGee and Frances Hudson McGee. He lived all of his life in the Pelham area where he was a 1959 graduate of Cobb Memorial High School. He worked on the balance crew for Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company for 31 years until his retirement in 2003. He was a member of the Pelham Volunteer Fire Department for 32 years where he served on the board and was a member of the Pelham United Methodist Church. One of his favorite past times was riding motorcycles.

On July 3, 1987, he married Elaine Henderson McGee, who survives of the residence. In addition to his parents he is predeceased by his brother, James "Jimmy" Howard McGee.

Funeral services will be conducted on Monday, May 15, 2017 at 2:30 p.m. at the Wrenn-Yeatts Westover Chapel with the Reverend Avery Marshall and Pastor Ray Mintz officiating. Interment will follow the service in Danville Memorial Gardens. The family will receive friends from 1 p.m. to 2:30 p.m. prior to the service and at other times will be at the residence.

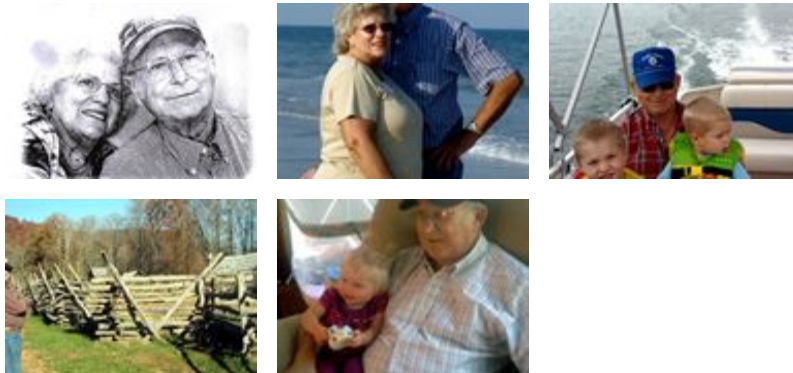
