Travis Mark Michael Greenfield, 34, of 115 Agnor Circle, Danville, VA died suddenly on Monday, November 11, 2013 at Moses-Cone Hospital in Greensboro, NC.

Born in San Diego, CA on January 1, 1979, Travis was the son of Jeffrey Lynn Greenfield and Laurette Freeman Greenfield.

He lived in California, Lowville, NY, and most of his life in Danville, VA. He worked for Smokey Bones Restaurant in Greensboro where he was an excellent server. He was an event coordinator at Chemistry in Greensboro and a Drag Queen.

He was predeceased by his biological parents, Earl James Greenfield and Ann Salmon Greenfield, his Paternal Grandmother, Myrtle Mae Greenfield, and his Maternal Grandfather, George "Poppy" Freeman, Sr.

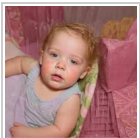

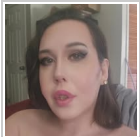
