Victor Henry Moon, 88, of 629 Mowbray Arch died, Friday, April 29, 2016 at Danville Regional Medical Center after a decline in health over the past two years.

Mr. Moon was born on May 26, 1927, a son of the late James William Moon, Sr. and Virginia Florence Strange Moon.
