



Vilma Harvey Barbour

January 22, 1928 - April 4, 2016

Vilma Harvey Barbour, 88, died on Monday, April 4, 2016 at Brookdale of Danville, after being in declining health for the past 10 years.

Mrs. Barbour was born in Danville, VA on January 22, 1928, daughter of the late James Oakey Harvey and the late Iva Stephens Harvey. She spent her life in the Danville and Patrick County areas where she was a homemaker. She was a member of Calvary Baptist Church in Patrick County, VA, where she was a Sunday school teacher and choir director, she later became a member of Vandola Baptist Church in 1995. She was a seamstress who sewed the uniforms for the first Flag Corps in 1974, then donated the proceeds to the band booster club. Mrs. Barbour loved to keep her children and grandchildren and will be missed greatly by her family.

On April 13, 1968 she married, Calvin Maurice Barbour who died on May 1, 2015.
