Violet Phinney Allen, 94, of 107 Wimbish Place, Danville, VA, died Monday, February 19, 2018 at Roman Eagle Memorial Home after a decline in her health for the past seven months.

Born in Lancaster, Wisconsin on May 4, 1923, Violet was a daughter of the late Neil Phinney and Nellie McDonald Phinney. She lived most of her life in Danville, VA.

She was a member of Stokesland United Methodist Church where she served as a Sunday School Teacher, as the former Church Secretary, the Church Friendship Club, as the assistant Financial Secretary, the Official Church Board and in various other positions of the church.

Violet was a veteran, serving in the U.S. Army in WWII. She was a member of the American Legion Post 325.

On October 1, 1945 she married Herman Lee Allen, he died on April 21, 2010. Their fondest memories in life include her many family beach trips, mountain trips and exploration of the American West.

In addition to her husband, she was predeceased by a son, Jerry Lee Allen, a brother, Leonard Phinney, and a sister, Ruth P. Woods.

Survivors include a son, Ronald M. Allen, of Danville, VA; a daughter, Judith Elaine Allen, of Raleigh, NC; two grandchildren, Jennifer Lynn Allen, of Danville, VA, and Neil Allen, of San Antonio, TX; and three great grandchildren, Jenna Thurman, Stone Thurman, and Noah Thurman.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday, February 24, 2018, at 2:00 P.M. at the Wrenn-Yeatts Westover Chapel with the Reverend Daryl Joyce officiating. Interment will follow in Highland Burial Park with military honors conducted by the American Legion Dan River Post 1097 Honor Guard.

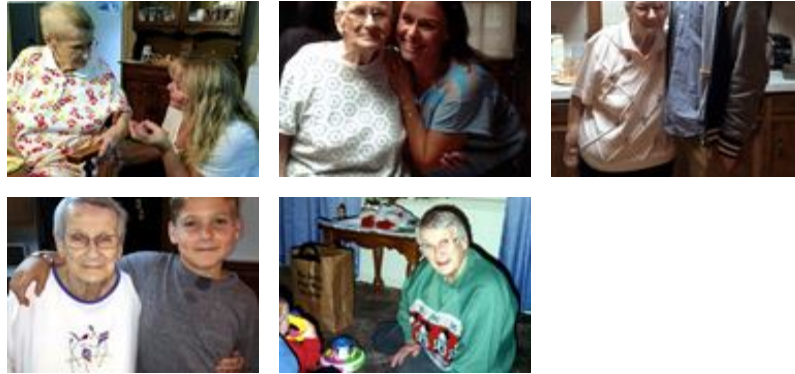
