Virginia Ann Motley Clark, 86, of the Vandola Community went home to be with her Lord and Savior on Sunday, March 9, 2025.

Born in Danville, VA on April 4, 1938, a daughter of the late Zenus Timothy Motley and Virginia Henderson Motley.
