Virginia Tice Richardson, 96, formally of the Keeling Community passed away peacefully on Friday, September 11, 2015 at her residence in Midlothian, VA.

Mrs. Richardson was born in Nelson County, VA on June 14, 1919 a daughter of the late William Leonard Tice and Esther Coffey Tice.

Mrs. Richardson worked as a Bank Teller for the former Fidelity Bank in Lynchburg, VA. She was a member of North Main Baptist Church and was a volunteer at Danville Memorial Hospital for many years.

Mrs. Richardson was first married to the late John Quinn Dillard and then on February 14, 1976 she married John Jennings Richardson, who died on May 14, 2012.
