November 11, 1928 - January 28, 2017

Vivian Naomi Pangle Peyton, 88, departed this world after 18 months of declining health to claim her heavenly reward on January 28, 2017. Born November 11, 1928 at home, in Augusta County, she was the daughter of Susie Francis Bailey Pangle and Guy Preston Pangle.

She worked 42 years at the Waynesboro DuPont plant, where she started working when she was 16 years old, devoted her life to her family, and supported her children and grandchildren by attending all of their activities including dance, soccer, baseball, cheerleading, plays, and school events. Until her health prevented it, she attended West Waynesboro Church of Christ. During the last four years of her life, she lived in Danville, VA with her daughter and was ministered to by Trinity United Methodist Church and the Episcopal Church of the Epiphany.

She was preceded in death by her parents, an infant daughter Pamela Lee Peyton, and her brothers Ray Arthur Pangle, Russell Eugene Pangle, Carl Strother Pangle, and a sister Virginia Catherine Pangle Coffey.
