



Walter Sager Taylor

April 29, 1924 - August 25, 2016

Walter Sager Taylor, 92, of Danville, VA died on Thursday, August 25, 2016 at Danville Regional Medical Center after a decline in health for the past two months.

Mr. Taylor was born in the Schoolfield Community of Danville, VA on April 29, 1924, son of the late Walter Claude Taylor and the late Joie Howard Taylor. He spent all of his life in the Danville area where he worked as a Mechanic for forty-eight years for Swanson Motor Company. He served his country in the U.S. Navy from 1943 to 1946. He was a member of the American Legion Post 1097 and he was a charter member of the Emmanuel Church of the Brethren.

On December 25, 1950, he married Frances Dillon Taylor, who died on July 16, 2013.

In addition to his parents and wife he was predeceased by two sisters, Jackie T. Ferguson and Iris Taylor Hawker.

He is survived by his sister, Faye Taylor Murdock and husband William C. Murdock; a niece, Donna C. Ferguson and husband Harold G. Moran; a great niece, Joie L. Robinson; a great-great nephew, Kyle E. Mascetti; and two great-great nieces, BreAnne E. Mascetti and Olivia T. Gray.

Funeral services will be conducted on Monday, August 29, 2016 at 2:00 PM at the Wrenn-Yeatts Westover Chapel with the Reverend Curtis English officiating. Interment will follow the service in Danville Memorial Gardens with military honors conducted by the American Legion Post 1097 Honor Guard and the U.S. Navy.
