Catherine Wanda Lovelace McCubbins, 75, of Danville died Sunday, July 30, 2017.

Mrs. McCubbins was born in Danville, VA on August 18, 1941 the daughter of the late David "D.K." Kelley Lovelace and Ruth Carter Lovelace.

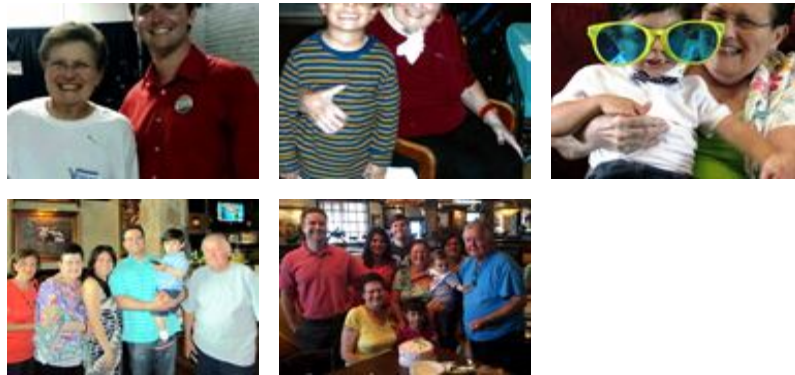
