Carroll Wayne Hudson, 74, of 2248 Inman Rd, Danville, died Tuesday, June 05, 2012 at his residence after being in declining health with cancer two years.

Born on February 19, 1938 in Pittsylvania County he was the son of the late Clyde Fleetwood Hudson and Iris Canady Hudson.

Mr. Hudson owned and operated Hudson Lawnmower Small Engine Repair and attended Brosville United Methodist Church. He served in the U.S. Navy from 1955-1958.

On November 29 1959, he married Joan Haymore Hudson, who died on January 15, 2008, and then on August 10, 2011, he married Judy Tuck Hudson, who survives.
