Willie Mae Ballew Walton, 67, of 8260 Kentuck Road, Ringgold, VA, died on Wednesday, September 11, 2013 at her residence after a decline in health for several months.

Mrs. Walton was born on February 3, 1946 a daughter of the late Reid Austin Ballew and the late Isabel Mary Wiseman Ballew. She spent her early life in Burnsville, NC and then on Meadow View Farm on Kentuck Road in Ringgold, VA where she worked as a hairdresser.

She was a member of Laurel Grove Baptist Church where she was a Sunday School Teacher and she also worked in the nursery.

On October 10, 1971 she married Bobby Dean Walton who died on June 3, 1998.

Survivors include one son, Thomas Dean Walton and wife Kabrina of Ringgold, VA; one granddaughter, Hannah Walton; a brother, Robert M. Ballew of Reidsville, NC; two nieces and two nephews.

In addition to her parents and her husband she was predeceased by a sister Mary Ellen B. Burns.
