September 15, 1936 - January 13, 2023

Wilson Junior Scott, 86, of Danville went home to be with the Lord on Friday, January 13, 2023.

Born in Ferrum, VA on September 15, 1936 a son of the late Columbus "Lum" Scott and Elizabeth Arbet Griffith Scott.

Junior served in the Virginia National Guard. He worked at Dan River Mills and retired from Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company in 2000 after 28 years of service. He attended Community Baptist Church as long as his health permitted.

On October 27, 1967 he married Doris Pruitt Scott, who survives.

Survivors also include a daughter, Gina S. Craig (Tom) and extended family, Mary Anne Dalton (Tim), Anna Dun (Ben), Emily Dalton, Carol Milam.

He was the last survivor of his generation being predeceased by brothers, Claude, Guy, Charlie Scott, and sisters, Lillian Davis, Mary Hall, Odette Green, Christine Law, Jearline Lynch, and a son, James Michael Scott.

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, January 18, 2023 at 2:00 PM at the Wrenn-Yeatts Westover Chapel with the Rev. David Turbyfill officiating.

Interment will follow in Danville Memorial Gardens.

The family will receive friends one hour prior to the service on Wednesday at the funeral home and at the residence at other times.
