



## Winston Woodroe Stevens

May 6, 1944 - May 3, 2016

Winston Woodroe Stevens, 71, of 122 Lynch Street died Tuesday, May 03, 2016 at Duke University Medical Center.

Mr. Stevens was born in Halifax County, VA on May 6, 1944, a son of the late James Woodrow Stevens and Mildred Ingram Stevens. Mr. Stevens served in the US Army from 1961-1963. He retired from Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company and was a member of Arbor Baptist Church and attended St. Marks Pentecostal Holiness Church. Woodroe was also known for selling Watermelons and Cantaloupe.

On October 9, 1964 he married, Frances Robertson Stevens, who survives of the residence.

Survivors also include two sons, Robert Allen Stevens, and wife, Sheri, of Sutherlin; Mark Winston Stevens, of Keeling; four grandchildren, Stephanie Seay and husband Cody, Ethan Stevens and wife Mary, Haley and James Stevens; great granddaughter, Karrington Seay; a mother-in-law, Hattie R. Hardy, of the residence.

He was predeceased by a sister, Diana Davis.
